
**Subject: Revision of cost norms for Meadow Orchard of Guava
under National Horticulture Mission (NHM)-reg.**

Sir,

Kindly refer to the implementation of National Horticulture Mission (NHM) during 11th Plan period. As per the existing guidelines of NHM, under establishment of new gardens, Cost Intensive Fruits include the crops like Grapes, Strawberry, Kiwi and Passion Fruits with the unit cost of Rs. 1.00 lakh per ha. and maximum subsidy of Rs. 50,000/- per ha. Based on the representation received from the States and keeping in view the higher cost of cultivation of Meadow Orchard of Guava, with the approval of competent authority it has been decided to include Meadow Orchard of Guava under the category of Cost Intensive Fruits from 2011-12.
